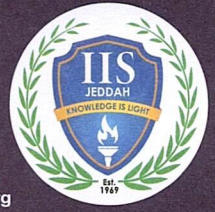

Scope of Work:

The service provider shall provide pest control solutions targeting, but not limited to, the following:

Types of Pests: Rodents, cockroaches, ants, termites, flies, mosquitoes, and any other common pests as needed.

Coverage Areas: Include all indoor and outdoor spaces such as offices, warehouses, cafeterias, storage areas, etc.

Frequency of Service:

The pest control treatments should be environmentally friendly, using products and methods that are safe for humans, pets, and plants.

Service Requirements:

Experience: Minimum 3-5 years of experience in pest control for commercial properties.

Reporting: Detailed monthly reports on services provided, pest findings, treatments applied, and recommendations.
